In the Rockford district office, she is responsible for all communication and public relations functions, and she works as a bridge between constituents and the federal government helping them to resolve issues.

Prior to her work in Congress, Torina worked for United Technologies Aerospace Systems where she worked as a contract administrator for the NASA space shuttle Orion program team. There she was able to work alongside NASA for the Journey to Mars Expo at the Chicago Air and Water Show, in addition to being the project manager for the NASA Journey to Mars supplier appreciation event. Torina also co-led Women in Aerospace, an employee resource group with a membership of 500+. She created a communications strategy and fresh programming which significantly increased employee engagement and established nationally benchmarked practices. Additionally, Torina was assigned the role of project manager for a campus-wide event Take Your Child To Work Day, a 1,000 person inititative with 100 volunteers. Her expert leadership of this project awarded her the prestigious United Technologies Level 1 Award.

Her early career was spent at Landstar System Inc. where over the course of 10 years she worked in various sales and marketing roles. Torina prides herself on "creating social media content in the early 2000's when you didn't have anyone to copy from." As an owner-operator recruiter in the marketing department, she gained a variety of knowledge in trade show management, advertising, email campaigns, budgets, and marketing based on needs industry trends. Torina also was responsible for creating and facilitating online training programs.

She volunteers as a registrar with Laundry Love, a non-profit organization that helps low income families wash and dry their clothes.
